Subject:	Draft European Council conclusions on energy prices

## **ENERGY PRICES**

- 1. The European Council addressed the recent spike in energy prices and its impact on citizens and businesses.
- 2. The toolbox presented in the Commission Communication on tackling rising energy prices contains useful measures in both the short and the longer term.
- 3. The European Council invites:
  - the Member States and the Commission to make the best use of this toolbox to provide short-term relief to the most vulnerable consumers and to support European companies;
  - the Commission and the Council to consider medium and long-term measures that would mitigate excessive price fluctuations, increase the EU's energy resilience and ensure a successful green transition;

- the European Investment Bank to look into its capital headroom to speed up investment in the green transition, with a view to reducing future disruption risks and meeting Europe's global connectivity ambitions.
- 4. The extraordinary meeting of the TTE Council (Energy) on 26 October will take this work forward immediately. The European Council will keep the situation under review and revert as needed.
